Program to Program Articulation Agreement Between Community College of Allegheny County And La Roche College

Community College of Allegheny County: Associate's Degree in Nursing

La Roche College: Bachelor of Science Nursing

This agreement made between Community College of Allegheny County (hereinafter "CCAC"), located at 800 Allegheny Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and La Roche College is effective as of date of final signature.

Under the provisions of this agreement, La Roche College will grant CCAC graduates who have completed the Associate's degree in Nursing at CCAC since May 2013, transfer credit hours in the field of Nursing (provided students received a minimum grade of C in transferable course work with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale). The specific CCAC courses eligible for such transfer credit are outlined in the chart attached to this document. These credits will apply toward graduation requirements in the Bachelor of Science in Nursing.

- 1. Students will be awarded the following:
 - Transfer credits from Community College, exclusive of pre-college work (i.e., developmental courses), provided students received a minimum grade of C (2.0 on a 4.0 GPA scale) in such course work.
 - Waiver of two La Roche College's Academic Core Required Courses. Students are still required to complete 120 credits for graduation, therefore additional coursework will be transferred in as courses outlined in the equivalency chart. Required courses are also outlined in the equivalency chart.
- Transfer candidates who have met the above provisions and who present at least 60 hours of transferable academic work will be granted junior class status in the Bachelor of Science.

- 3. La Roche College will offer CCAC graduates merit scholarships from \$6,000 -\$14,000 per year for full time enrolled students. Members of Phi Theta Kappa will be awarded the maximum scholarship amount. Students will continue to receive this scholarship during the course of their time at La Roche College provided that a minimum of 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 GPA scale is met.
- 4. Transfer candidates must complete their last 30 semester credits through La Roche College in order to receive the Bachelor's degree, regardless of their class status upon matriculation at La Roche College.
- 5. La Roche College and CCAC will monitor the academic performance of students enrolling under this agreement, identify concerns, and work cooperatively to ensure ease of transfer for students participating in the program. Both institutions will notify each other in a timely fashion concerning any curriculum or program changes.
- 6. La Roche College and CCAC agree to publicize this agreement among students, faculty, counseling staff, and administration.

PURPOSE: The purpose of the RN-BSN program is to expand the knowledge base and scope of practice of the ASN/Diploma prepared RN. The RN-BSN completion program expands the practice and knowledge base rooted in nursing science and liberal arts. Graduates of the program are generalists with foundation for graduate education and continuing professional development.

REQUIREMENTS: To successfully complete the BSN major, the following coursework is required:

- 36 credits Nursing Mobility Profile II, Direct Articulation Agreement, or PA Articulation Agreement
- 12 Prerequisite science credits (Block)
- 12 Prerequisite or Co-requisite required courses (ENGL 1011, ENGL 1012, PSYC 1021, SOCL 1021)
- 30 Liberal Arts credits
- 18 Nursing Component credits
- 12 credits of Nursing Electives
- A minimum number of 120 credits are required for degree, the last 30 of which must be earned at La Roche College. (Developmental course work does not count toward the minimum number of required credits for graduation.)
