An articulation agreement exits between the accredited associate degree Diet Technician Program (DIT) at the Community College of Allegheny County (CCAC), and the accredited Bachelor of Science degree in the Nutrition & Dietetics Program (DPD) at the University of Pittsburgh School of Health and Rehabilitation Sciences

TRANSFERABLE PREREQUISITE COURSES

The CCAC courses, which have been identified as transferable in meeting the DPD Prerequisites Course Requirements are listed on page 2.

Note:

The Introductory Nutrition course listed on page 2 as NUTR/HRS 1006 is a human nutrition course offered by the Nutrition Department to meet specific accreditation standards of education. A review of the course objectives and syllabus for the CCAC course, DIT 106 Nutrition Care 1, indicates that this course is equivalent to NUTR/HRS 1006 and therefore is the course that is accepted as the transferable introductory nutrition course. The Bio 117 Nutrition course is <u>not</u> accepted as equivalent.
